REO Removable Kit Installation Instructions


Tools Required:

- 1 Base plate adapter
- 1 Socket
- 4 3/8-16 hex nut
- 4 5/16" Flat washer
- 4 3/8-16 3/4" Flat head screw
- 2-1/2" Concrete Drill Bit

Core Drill

- 7/32" Allen Wrench
- Cement
- Shop Vac

- Installation Instructions
 - 1. Attach the base plate adapter to the bottom of the post using the 4 head screws, flat washers, and hex nuts as shown in the figure on the right.
 - 2. At the installation site, mark the center location for each post.
 - Using the core drill, drill a 2 1/2" diameter X 4 1/4" deep hole at each centerline location. Vacuum ALL dust and debris from each hole. If this is not done correctly, the posts may not be seat properly.
 - 4. Fill each hole with 2" of concrete and place a socket in each hole, making sure that the tops of the sockets are flush with the floor. Place the posts in the sockets, making sure any rail outlets are aligned correctly, and make sure that the posts are straight and level.
 - 5. Allow the concrete to set. Once concrete has set, remove the post and fill the remaining area around the socket with concrete. Allow the concrete to set again.
 - 6. Reinsert the posts into the sockets and insert any connecting rails between the posts.
 - 7. Insert the base cover over the post flange.

Maintenance:

Clean posts and rails with the correct type of cleaner for their finish:

- Chrome: Use a general all-purpose cleaner with a soft cloth
- Stainless Steel: Use a Stainless Steel polish or cleaner. If a heavy scratch or mark is apparent use a metal blend or finish pad.
- Powder coat: Use a soft damp cloth. Any deep scratches or chips should be touched up to prevent rust.

NOTE If untreated, rust will spread under the surface.

Replace any bent or broken pieces IMMEDIATELY.

Periodically tighten any loose bolts.
